

Under the Local Transparency Code of 2014, local authorities must publish quarterly data which includes all expenditure exceeding £500; government procurement card transactions and procurement information for details of every invitation to tender for contracts to provide goods or services with a value that exceeds £5,000.

Expenditure exceeding £500

Guidance issued by the Local Government Association states that this includes items of expenditure such as: individual invoices; grant payments; expense payments; payments for goods and services; grants; grant in aid; rent; credit notes over £500 and transactions with other public bodies

For the period April to June 2015 there were no payments exceeding £500

Government Procurement Card Transactions

For the period April to June 2015 there were no government procurement card transactions.
