### Actions for 2016/17

### Ongoing Actions:

- To offer training and development opportunities for all councillors and the Clerk.

- To encourage regular litter picking and verge/hedge pruning within the parish
- To ensure the village has representation within the Neighbourhood Watch Scheme
- To respond to all planning consultations

- To maintain a strategic overview of traffic matters within and around Lindsey working with the Highways Department in Suffolk County Council to improve drainage issues at strategic points in the village and improvements to road surfacing and to investigate improvements to the upkeep of roadside verges.

- To work with members of the Community to ensure information relating to the provision of faster broadband is available to all
